

**University of Kentucky Latin American  
Studies Program Travel Grants for Research  
in Latin America**

The Latin American Studies Program invites UK Graduate Students to apply for Summer Travel Grants for research in Latin America. The primary purpose of these grants is to enable students to pursue intensive research on a topic related to the doctoral dissertation. Applications for exploratory, intermediate as well as consolidating stages of the project are welcome.

Applications are judged on the basis of the quality of the proposal, the student's academic standing, and the relationship of the proposed travel and summer research to the student's long term academic and professional goals. We encourage everyone to apply; however, depending on the number of applications received, priority will be given to students who have not received these grants in the last two years.

Grants are intended to contribute to the costs of airfare, lodging and minimal research expenses. It is expected that successful applicants will spend no less than three weeks in-country. On their return from Latin America, grantees are required to submit a two-page report detailing research accomplishment under the terms of the grant and an expense report. Grantees are also required to present their research results at a seminar or roundtable discussion in the 2011-2012 academic year or participation in the Latin American Studies Graduate Students Symposium if organized that year.

**Applications consist of:**

1) A completed application form (enclosed) 2) A two-page proposal (double space, Times New Roman, 12 p). Please no more than two pages. This proposal must provide the following information:

- Description of the project
- Research methodologies to be used
- Relationship of the project to the student's academic and professional goals
- The student's preparation for the project, including a list of relevant course work and evidence of their language skills. Applicants should also include a description of prior research and travel experience in Latin America. While it is highly desirable that the application shows prior contact with individuals and institutions in the country of choice and includes assurance to in-country cooperation and access to sources, this is not required.

3) A budget for the project (including estimated airfare, lodging, sustenance, in-country travel, and research expenses). Please highlight how you intend to use funding from LAS.

4) An unofficial copy of the student's transcript.
